Over the past couple of months we have received numerous calls from residents of Stokenchurch who are concerned about the speed vehicles are travelling through the village.

In response, your neighbourhood policing team has teamed up with Stokenchurch Parish Council to hold a speed awareness week from Monday 10th March. We are mobilising extra speed enforcement patrols in an attempt to deter motorists from speeding through Stokenchurch in the future. Fixed penalty notices will be issued to any offending motorists, therefore please be mindful of the speed you are travelling to ensure we do not have to issue you with a fine.

As a resident of Stokenchurch we would like you to assist us with enforcing the speed limit in the village by simply abiding to the limits yourself therefore making those behind you drive safely as possible.
